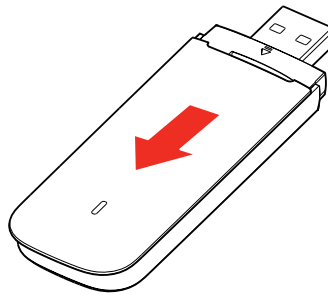

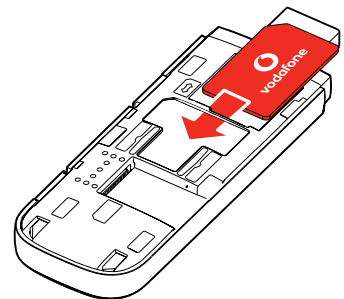

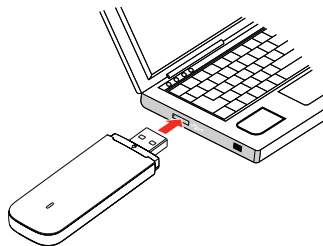
1 Open

connected to the internet.

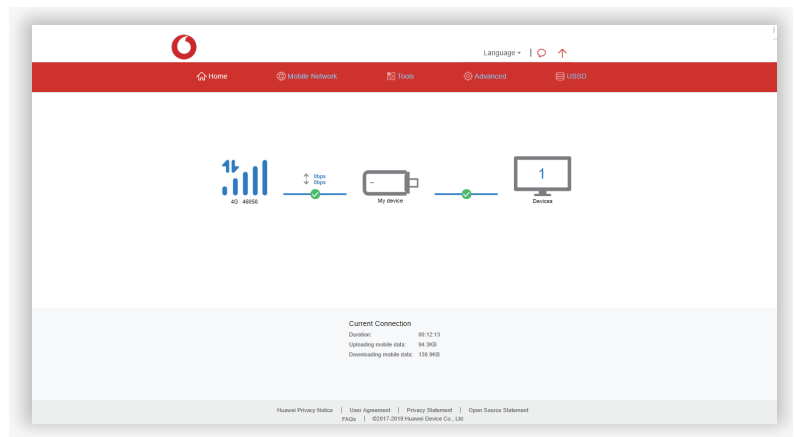
You may also be asked to
